

Dr. Hohmann Grant 2025

The Cologne Geographical Society (Gesellschaft für Erdkunde zu Köln) supports research projects by young geographers at universities in North Rhine-Westphalia (e.g. dissertation or habilitation projects) as part of the Dr. Hohmann research grant.

The research grant originates from a donation by pharmacist Dr. Hans Hohmann to the Cologne Geographical Society for the purpose of promoting young talent in the field of human-environment research.

A grant of up to €5,000 can be awarded to cover travel, material or publication costs. The deadline for applying for the Dr. Hohmann grant is October 15, 2025. Funding from the Cologne Geographical Society is compatible with other grants. Criteria for the award include scientific excellence, originality and feasibility of the research project.

The following documents need to be submitted:

- Concept and objectives of the research project (max. 2 pages)
- Work plan and timetable
- Cost plan and funding requirements
- Letter of reference from a university lecturer
- curriculum vitae
